Preferred Teaching Strategy:

Audit Interactive employs a specific educational expectation model. We ask that speakers divide each of their sessions into three teaching outcomes:

Learn – Speakers transfer knowledge of the topic’s principle definitions, strategies, and guidelines

Apply – Speakers provide details (tools, references) on how to use the new knowledge in office

Collaborate – Speakers provide attendees an opportunity to work together on a learning exercise (problem solving, case study, role play)

Topic Proposals

The speaker submission process is collaborative and focused on delivering relevant content to the ACUA AI audience. The Conference Planning Committee enthusiastically welcomes relevant topic proposals and suggest a few topics below:

Session Length
